FY2526 Tri-City Fire Department Budget/ Expiring Board Member Terms

Rob Kalman has served for many years and would like to continue to serve as the Keego Harbor representative on the Tri-City Fire Board.

Resolution 25-10 WRC Water Supply Rate

The water supply rate will increase by 7.7%.

Resolution 25-11 WRC Sewer Disposal Rate

Sewer sales are down due to conservation, lowering operational costs, resulting in a quarterly charge increase of \$0.23. The mayor would like Keego Harbor to be consulted before rate increases are set next year.

2025-2027 Marine Patrol Agreement/ 4th of July

The grant to use Oakland County Marine Patrol services is for one year with a second- and third-year option. Chief Barnes is working on staffing, and the City

Manager was directed to draft a request letter to the Sheriff's office. The Council Members discussed 4th of July shoreline traffic management, including beach entrance fees for non-residents.

Resolution 25-12 Millage Rate Resolution

This is an annual millage rate request to the County Board of Commissioners to levy a percentage of taxes based on the Headlee maximum allowable.

Resolution 25-13 Special Tax for Act 359

This is an annual resolution to levy a special tax for publicity not to exceed \$50,000.

Notice to Taxpayers-Tax Collection Dates

This notice is a standard notice that needs to be sent to residents by law.

Street Sweeping Cass Lake Road- Memorial Day Parade

TIFA has approved \$620 to be paid to Eagle Eye Sweeping for services to be completed ahead of the Memorial Day Parade.

Resolution 25-14 Permit Waiver Program

The City Council would like to bring the permit waiver program back to help residents make improvements to their properties during June, July, and August. Originally implemented in 2009, the program details were discussed.

PEG/Franchise Fees

The City Council discussed future options for the PEG and franchise fees, and what the state allows.
