A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING HB 5848

Motion by Council Member Kalman seconded by Council Member Gubka

WHEREAS, the City of Keego Harbor is required to publish a legal notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the City; and

WHEREAS, the cost to publish such legal notices has increased over the years by as much as 300 percent; and

WHEREAS, publication cut off dates are not always conducive for the city.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that HB 5848 would help alleviate part of this burden.


In light of the foregoing it was moved by Council Member Kalman and Council Member Gubka seconded by that the Keego Harbor City Council supports the following proposed House Bill language in regard to publishing legal notices:

Notwithstanding any Charter provision, a City that is required to publish a legal notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the City may satisfy that requirement by posting the legal notice in the office of the City Clerk and on at least one of the following:

- (A) The City Website.
- (B) The website of the newspaper designated by the City as the official newspaper of general circulation in the City.
- (C) The public, education, and government channel operating in that City, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of said resolution shall be forwarded to all Oakland County Municipalities and State Representatives.
