DEMOLITION REQUIREMENTS

The following items will need to be submitted before a demolition permit will be issued for a commercial or a residential property.

1. Copy of the Sewer Disconnect Permit from Oakland County.
2. Copy of electricity disconnect from Detroit Edison.
3. Copy of gas disconnect from Consumers Energy.
4. Copy the Water Disconnect from Water Resources Commissioner (WRC).
5. If the home is within 500 feet of water, a Soil and Erosion Permit from Water Resources Commissioner (WRC).

A demolition permit will not be issued until all the above items have been submitted with a permit application.
