

## FENCE

## FENCE- SECTION 15.12 OF ZONING ORDINANCE

Permits Needed: Zoning

- On properties with an already existing fence, that existing fence must be removed prior to installation of a new or replacement fence.


## Application Requirements:

- Zoning Application
- All fences established on or near the property lines require a registered survey or mortgage survey.
- Sketch drawing showing the proposed location of the fence.
- Include specifications of the type of fence to be installed. Provide height, fence type, materials etc. Photos are helpful and can be included with permit application.


## - Fence Requirements:

a. Front Yard- 3' Tall, no closer than 10' to the road pavement. Decorative-50\% open to air and light, ex: wrought iron or picket No chain link or solid wood.
b. Interior Side Yard- 5' setback from the building line. Can be chain link or solid wood.
c. Side Yard Facing Road- 4 ' high with an additional 2' lattice. A minimum 10' setback from edge of road pavement. No chain link.
d. Rear Yard- 6 ' high. Can be chain link or solid wood.
e. Waterfront- 3' high, $5^{\prime}$ from sea wall or high-water mark, $75 \%$ open to air and light. Decorative. Ex: wrought iron.

Inspections: 1; Inspection from Building Official
*Fences are not permitted on vacant lots.
