

FENCE

FENCE- SECTION 15.12 OF ZONING ORDINANCE **Permits Needed:** Zoning

• On properties with an already existing fence, that existing fence must be removed prior to installation of a new or replacement fence.

Application Requirements:

- Zoning Application
- All fences established <u>on or near the property lines</u> require a registered survey or mortgage survey.
- Sketch drawing showing the proposed location of the fence.
- Include specifications of the type of fence to be installed. Provide height, fence type, materials etc. Photos are helpful and can be included with permit application.

• Fence Requirements:

- a. <u>Front Yard- 3</u>' Tall, no closer than 10' to the road pavement. Decorative-50% open to air and light, ex: wrought iron or picket No chain link or solid wood.
- b. <u>Interior Side Yard</u>- 5' setback from the building line. Can be chain link or solid wood.
- c. <u>Side Yard Facing Road</u>- 4' high with an additional 2' lattice. A minimum 10' setback from edge of road pavement. No chain link.
- d. <u>Rear Yard</u>- 6' high. Can be chain link or solid wood.
- e. <u>Waterfron</u>t- 3' high, 5' from sea wall or high-water mark, 75% open to air and light. Decorative. Ex: wrought iron.

Inspections: 1; Inspection from Building Official

*Fences are not permitted on vacant lots.
