WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2.2 of the City Charter for the City of Keego Harbor providing for the protection of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Keego Harbor and Section 4.2(b) Duties of Mayor of the City Charter for the City of Keego Harbor; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Governor of the State of Michigan issuing Executive Order 2020-97 (COVID-19), allowing outdoor restaurant seating; and Executive Order 2020-110 (COVID-19), which effects Oakland County, issued June 1, 2020, and

WHEREAS, the City of Keego Harbor wishes to safely allow the opening of the food and drink establishments with the City of Keego Harbor, and

WHEREAS, the City Council does not meet in regular session until June 18, 2020, and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 2020-110 (COVID-19) allows food and drink establishments to open effective June 8, 2020.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Rob Kalman, as Mayor of City of Keego Harbor hereby orders to suspend the enforcement of City ordinances regarding the establishment of outdoor food service, subject to the requirements of attached Exhibit A.
