Being that the skateboard community is so strong, Mayor of Sylvan Lake, Ben Clarke explains it to be an answer for a constructive place for teenagers and young adults to connect. New Business

Park Surveillance Leslie Clark and Angelic Arens lead much discussion on the need for some sort of park surveillance to protect the financial investment and the hard work of all the volunteers that have worked on the park installations and improvements to the city parks. There was a common consensus that it is not the responsibility of the Parks and Rec board members to paint and remove graffiti and vandalism from the parks considering the recent graffiti vandal attack on Baxter Morgan park. Mayor Brian Lampl addressed a few options on how to protect the property of the city parks with surveillance and signage. There was some discussion on designating a graffiti wall as a deterrent but did not get much support.

Cleaning and Repainting of Playground Equipment; Leslie described the research she put into how to remove the graffiti and that she washed and waxed them to make it easier to clean and remove paint for the future if necessary. She noted the last time they were painted was 2016. The picnic tables are clean for now, and a need for new soccer nets to be possible donated. A budget request to be set for up to 200.00 if the donation is not available this year.
