## 1. Pet Waste Disposal Facilities

Ideas discussed included home-made options, getting a business sponsor, buying 1 vs 2, and whether people would use them. Secretary Clark reported that we will know in December if we are getting a Recreation Passport grant. If we don't get that grant, we will need to contribute heavily to make the available CDBG funds cover the replacement of the playscape in Fran Leaf Park. The consensus was to table this to the January meeting.

### 2. 2016 Grant Completion & Reimbursement

Secretary Clark reported that we are waiting on the DNR to release an online document so that we may submit our final reimbursement request. We are also waiting on DPW to install signs and paint handicap parking spaces. As for the 2018 Recreation Passport grant applications, preliminary scoring was low, so the odds are not good for us to get those grants.

The subcommittee has met and finalized details. Promotion will begin at the very end of September. Prizes will be gift cards from the MJR movie theater.
