All guest vehicles must be parked on one side of the road only. They cannot block ingress or egress from anyone's driveway, someone's mailbox or a fire hydrant. The Chief of Police can only grant exemptions to local Keego Harbor parking ordinances. He cannot grant exemptions to state law, see a partial list below of State of Michigan Parking Regulations.

### **MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE (EXCERPT)**

#### **Act 300 of 1949**

#### **257.674 Prohibited parking; exceptions; bus loading zone; violation as civil infraction.**

Sec. 674.

(1) A vehicle must not be parked, except if necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the law or the directions of a police officer or traffic-control device, in any of the following places:

- (a) On a sidewalk.
- (b) In front of a public or private driveway.
- (c) Within an intersection.
- (d) Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant.
- (e) On a crosswalk.

(f) Within 20 feet of a crosswalk, or if there is not a crosswalk, then within 15 feet of the intersection of property lines at an intersection of highways.

I understand the Michigan Vehicle Code Act 300 above. I understand I can only use this request form 4 times a calendar year.
