## FENCES

## Permits Needed: Zoning

Application Requirements:

- Zoning application
- All fences installed on or near the property lines required a registered survey or a mortgage survey
- Marked up survey (if required) or sketch drawing showing the proposed location of the fence
- Fence details, including height and material. A photo of the proposed fence is helpful.

Inspections:

- 1 - post installation


## RESIDENTIAL FENCE STANDARDS (See Section 15.12 of zoning ordinance)

| Front Yard | Placed no closer than 10' <br> from road pavement | $3^{\prime}$ | Decorative with a minimum of <br> $50 \%$ open space (ex. Picket, <br> split rail, wrought iron) is <br> required. No chain link or solid <br> wood fences. |
| Side Lot Line Behind the <br> Building Line and Facing a <br> Road | Placed no closer than 10' <br> from the edge of the <br> road pavement or at the <br> property line, whichever <br> is greater | $4^{\prime}+2^{\prime}$ <br> additional <br> lattice (6' <br> total) | No chain link fences. |
| Side Yard (between the <br> front and rear building <br> lines) Not Facing a Road | Placed no closer than 5' <br> from front building line | $6^{\prime}$ | No restrictions |
| Rear Lot Line | May be located on rear <br> property line | $6^{\prime}$ | No restrictions |
| Rear Yard of a Through Lot <br> Where All of the Lots <br> Located on the Same Side <br> of the Street on that Block <br> are Through Lots | Placed no closer than 10' <br> from the edge of the <br> road pavement or at the <br> property line, whichever <br> is greater | $6^{\prime}$ | No restrictions |
| Rear Yard of a Through Lot <br> Where There is a Mix of <br> Through Lots and Non- <br> Through Lots on that <br> Block | Placed no closer than 10' <br> from the edge of the <br> road pavement or at the <br> property line, whichever <br> is greater | $4^{\prime}+2^{\prime}$ <br> additional <br> lattice (6 <br> total) | No restrictions |
| Waterfront Yard | Placed no closer than the <br> waters edge at a seawall <br> or 5' from the ordinary <br> high water mark | $3^{\prime}$ | Must be decorative with a <br> minimum of 75\% open (ex. <br> Picket, split rail, wrought iron) |

NON-RESIDENTIAL FENCE STANDARDS

| Use | Height Requirements | Material Requirements |
| :--- | :--- | :--- |
| Enclose public or <br> institutional playgrounds | Maximum height: 7' | Must be 75\% open |
| Non-residential districts | Maximum height: $6^{\prime}$ | Cannot extend toward the front of the lot <br> farther than any portion of the main building, <br> except for outdoor storage <br> No barbed wire or electrically-charged wiring |
| Outdoor storage in non- <br> residential districts | Minimum height: $6^{\prime}$ | No restrictions |

## ADDITIONAL NOTES

- Existing fences must be removed prior to the installation of a new or replacement fence
- Property owners must maintain fences and walls
