Market Analysis from Gibbs Planning Group

Robert J. Gibbs discussed the proposal from Gibbs Planning Group. Mr. Gibbs discussed the residential and commercial side of the Market Study his company would work on for Keego Harbor. He indicated the data doesn't rely on Census data. The Gibbs Planning Group will talk to local business and residents through focus groups. This Market Study will aid the City in planning policies, help existing businesses identify customers and spending potential and be a tool to get developers interested in Keego Harbor. Mr. Gibbs indicated the City will get a free update one year after the Market Survey is completed.
